## The Resource Connection Health and Safety Scholarship Application

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The Resource Connection Resource and Referral Services is offering Health & Safety Training funds to reimburse Licensed Center-based Staff, Licensed Family Child Care Providers, License-Exempt/TrustLine Child Care Providers and In-home Child Care providers that have completed the health and safety training requirements as outlined in AB243.

Each eligible provider may receive up to **\$150** towards payment for completed classes or course work per year. Reimbursement will not exceed the actual costs incurred. **Reimbursements will be provided on a first come, first serve basis.** Priorities for payments: Small Family Child Care Licensees (1 per facility), Large Family Child Care Licensee and Assistant (2 per facility); Private Child Care Center Director & Lead Teacher (2 per facility); TrustLine and Exempt Providers (provider only). Once all priorities are processed, any remaining funds will be distributed to additional applicants.

To qualify for this reimbursement, providers will need to:

- ◆ Provide care in Amador or Calaveras Counties;
- ◆ Be a newly licensed provider, a licensed provider, exempt or TrustLine provider, child care center director or staff who needs to obtain or renew their CPR or First Aid certificate(s);
- ◆ Complete the Health and Safety training between July 1, 2020 and June 15, 2021;
- ◆ All applications for reimbursement must be in the Resource and Referral office by June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

All child care providers, licensed or exempt from licensing, will benefit from attending a Child Care Health and Safety Course. However, there are child care providers in California who must take the course and re-certify regularly in order to have valid cards/certificates, (requirements outlined in AB243). The California Department of Social Services, Community Care Licensing (River City Child Care in Sacramento) is responsible for monitoring the requirement in licensed facilities.

### Family Child Care Home

<i>Personnel</i>	<i>Course Components Required</i>
All Licensees and co-licensees	Infant, Child Adult CPR, Pediatric First Aid, Preventive Health and Safety
Substitute (All licensees absent)	Licensee absent: Must ensure at least one staff member with current training in pediatric first aid and pediatric CPR is on site at all times while children are present.

### Child Care Center (Licensed)

<i>Personnel</i>	<i>Course Components Required</i>
At least one director or teacher	Adult, Infant, Child CPR, Pediatric First Aid, Preventive Health and Safety
At least one person present must have:	Infant, Child, Adult, CPR Pediatric First Aid
